## Becky's Beef Manhattans

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1 pound of deli thin sliced \*(chipped) roast beef  
2 cans Campbell's \*Beef Gravy (14.5 ounce cans)  
8 slices of white bread  
2 cups of prepared mashed potatoes (or more, if you like more tata's than that!)  
Salt and pepper to taste

This recipe is for 4 servings.....

In skillet place the roast beef and 1 can of gravy to just heat together.

Heat other can of gravy in small pan separate from the skillet.

On 4 separate plates put a slice of bread on the center of each plate then take the hot beef mixture and divide up on top of each piece of bread.

Top all 4 "sandwiches" with the remaining slice of bread. Cut the "sandwich" in a diagonal cut and spread apart.

Place ½ cup of mashed potatoes in the center of each cut "sandwich."

Now... making sure to divide evenly between the 4 plates, top with the other can of gravy you heated up in the smaller pan.

Serve with salad!

### **\*Recipe Note:**

These can also be made with thinly sliced turkey breast from the deli and Campbell's Turkey Gravy in the cans for a change of pace, or if you just prefer turkey to beef!!
