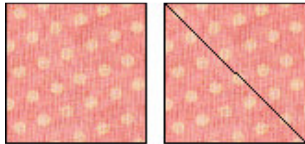
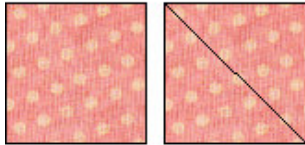


## Blueberry Compote

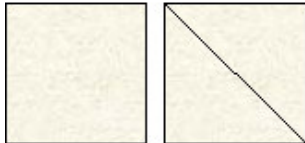
12" by 12" Finished Block



Cut 2 squares that are  $3 \frac{7}{8}$  Inch Square, then subcut them into 4 triangles. You will use 3 of the triangles for this block.



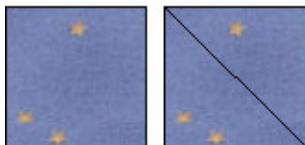
Cut one square that is  $6 \frac{7}{8}$ ", then subcut into 2 triangles. You will need 1 of the triangles for this block.



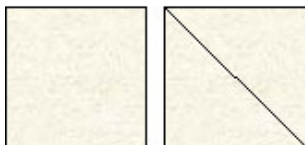
Cut one square that is  $6 \frac{7}{8}$ ", then subcut into 2 triangles. You will need 1 of the triangles for this block.



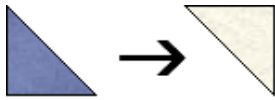
Cut 4 squares that are  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "



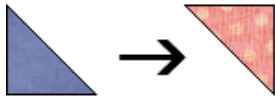
Cut 4 squares that are  $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Squares, then subcut these into 8 triangles.



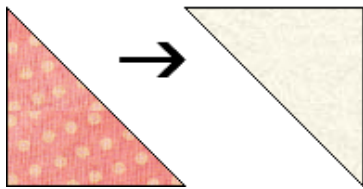
Cut 3 squares that are  $3 \frac{7}{8}$ ", then subcut these into 6 triangles. You will be using 5 of the triangles for this block.



Using a 1/4" seam, sew 5 of the blue triangles and 5 of the cream triangles together, making a total of 5 complete half square triangle units.



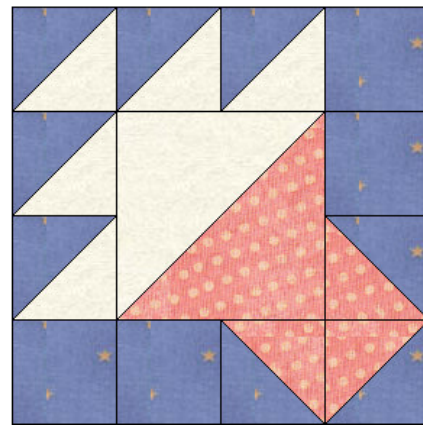
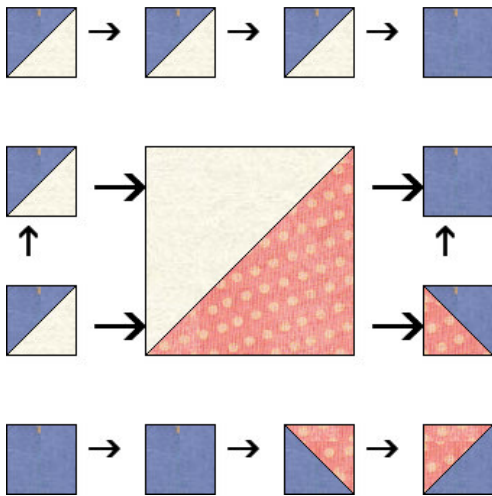
Using a 1/4" seam, sew 3 of the blue triangles and 3 of the pink print triangles together, making a total of 3 complete half square triangle units.



Using a 1/4" seam, take the large blue and pink print triangles and sew together making one large half square triangle unit for the center of your block.

Lay out your pieces, using the diagram as your guide and using a 1/4" seam, sew together. Press

Your block should now measure 12 1/2" Unfinished!



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
