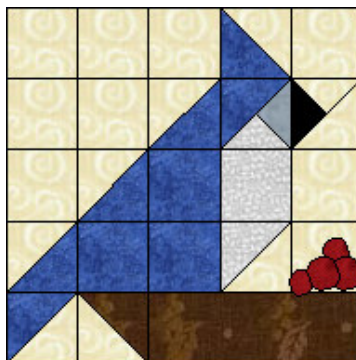




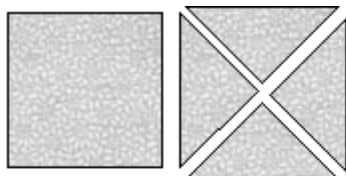

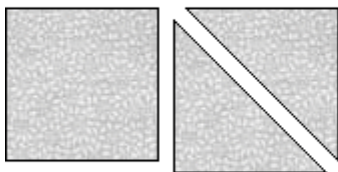


## Bluejay and Berries

10" Finished Block



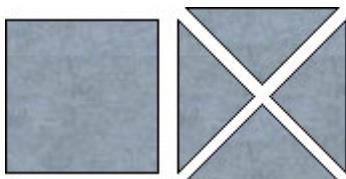
Cut one square that is  $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " then subcut this into 4 triangles, you will only be using 1 triangle for this block



Cut 1 square that is  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " and then subcut this into 2 triangles, you will only be using one of the triangles for this block



Cut 1 square that is  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "



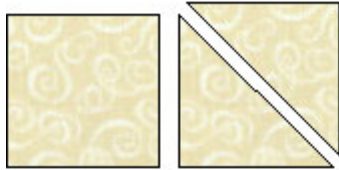
Cut one square that is  $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " then subcut this into 4 triangles, you will only be using 1 triangle for this block

Cut one square that is  $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " then subcut this into 4 triangles, you will only be using 1 triangle for this block



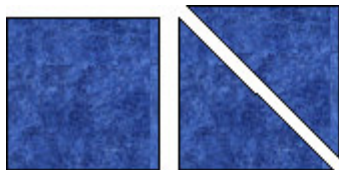
Cut 4 squares that are  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " then subcut these into 8 triangles



Cut 10 squares that are  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut 3 squares that are  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut 3 squares that are  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " and then subcut these into 6 triangles



Cut one square that is  $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " and then subcut this into 2 triangles, you will only be using one triangle for this block



Cut one rectangle that is  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ "



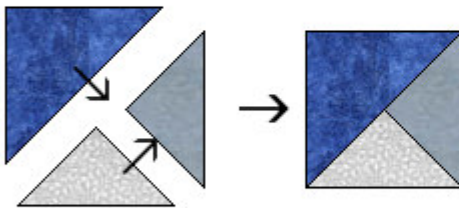
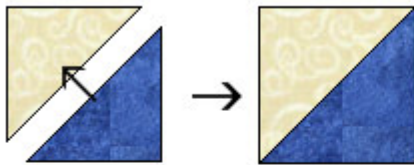
Using templates provided cut 2 of the small berries and 2 of the large berries

## Instructions

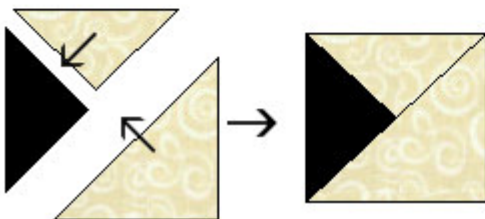

All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " in this block

Sew 5 white and 5 blue triangles together to make a total of 5 half square triangle sections

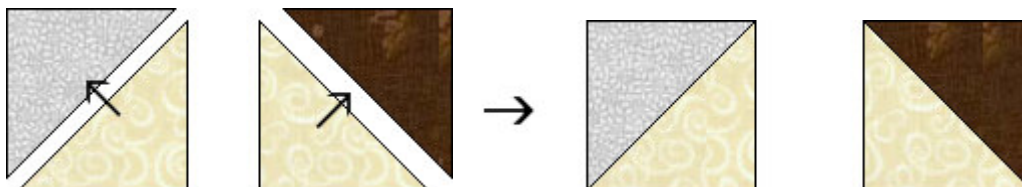


Sew together the gray and medium blue smaller triangles, and then sew these onto the one remaining large blue triangles as shown

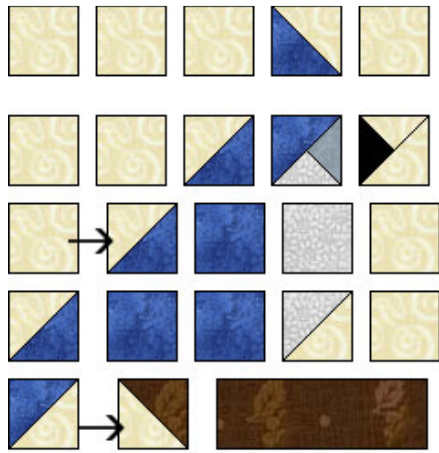


Sew together the black and white smaller triangles, and then sew these onto the one remaining large white triangle as shown

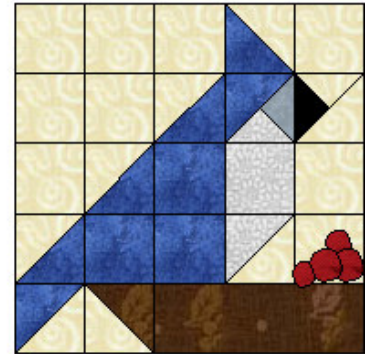
Sew together the remaining 2 white triangles to the gray triangle and the brown triangle as shown.



Now that you have all the units sewn together, lay them out as follows and sew your block together.



After sewing your block together make your berries and applique them onto the bird feeder. Your block should now measure 10 1/2" unfinished.
