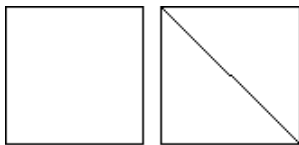


Columbian Puzzle

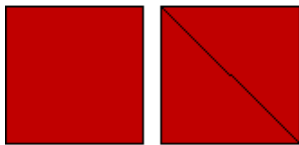
Finished block measures 12" by 12"



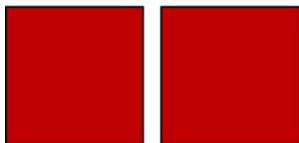
Cut 8 squares $2 \frac{7}{8}$ Inches and mark a diagonal line through the center. This will be your sewing line.



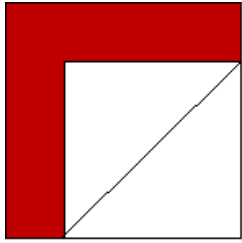
Cut 8 squares $3 \frac{1}{2}$ Inches



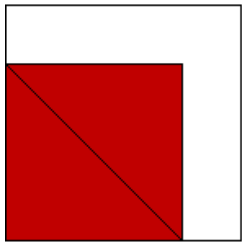
Cut 8 squares $2 \frac{7}{8}$ Inches and mark a diagonal line through the center. This will be your sewing line.



Cut 8 squares $3 \frac{1}{2}$ Inches

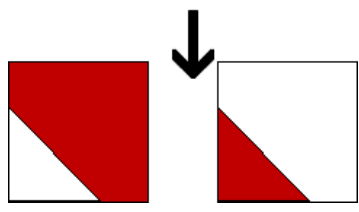


Take the red $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square and the $2\frac{7}{8}$ " white square and with right sides together sew on the drawn line. Cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " from sewn edge and press towards the dark side. Make 8 of these units.



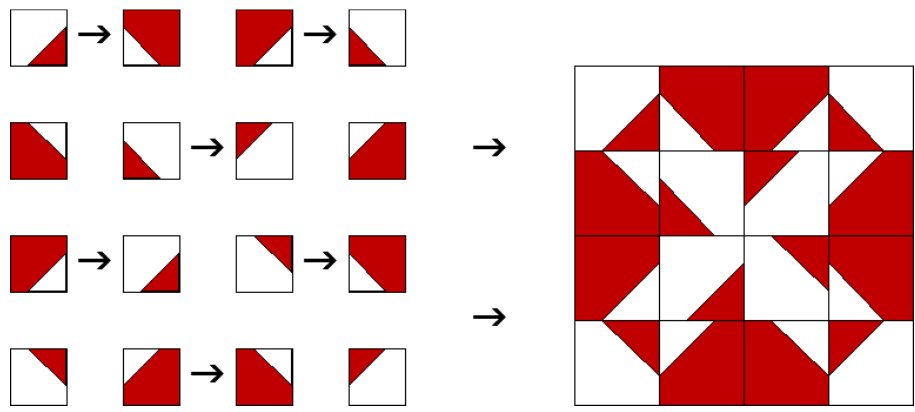
Now take the white $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square and the red $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square and repeat the procedure. Make 8 of these units.

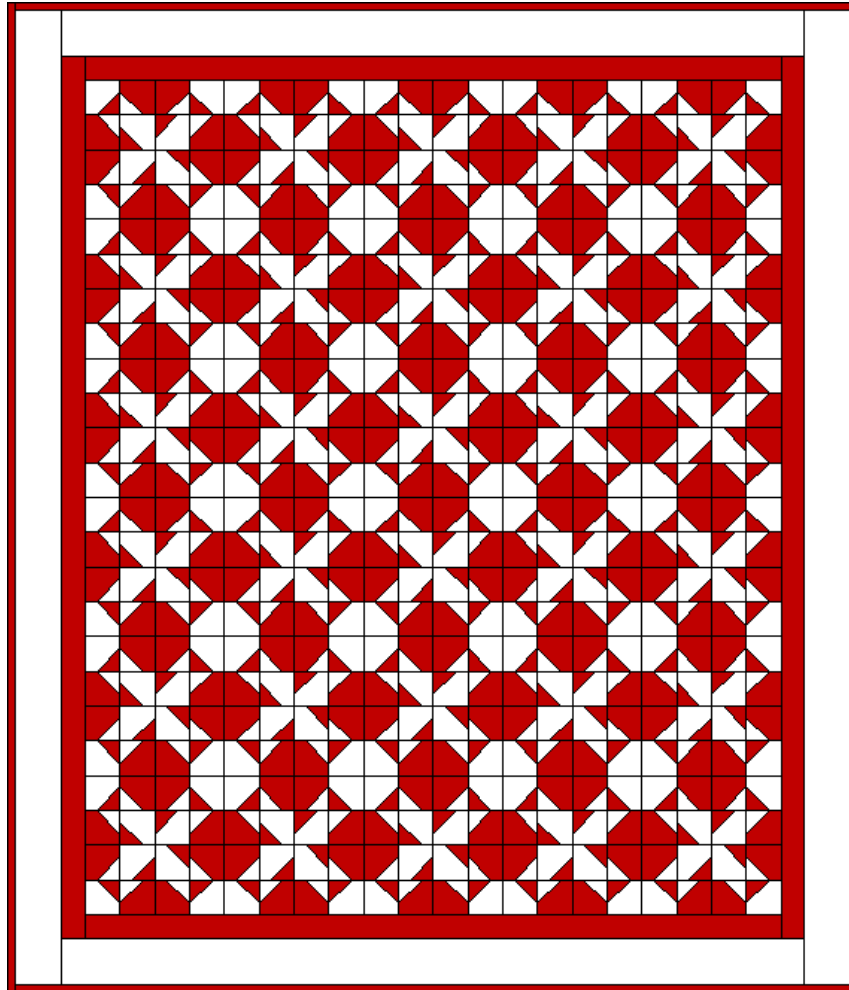
You should now have a total of 16 units that look similar to these.



Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, piece the block as shown in the diagram. Be careful not to stretch the bias!

Your block should now measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

Fabric Requirements

4 ¼ yards of white
4 ½ yards of red
