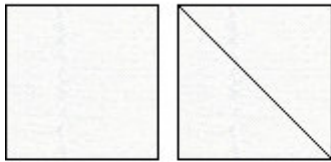


Cupid's Arrows

This block will measure 12" finished



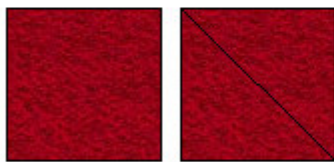
Cut 8 squares that are 2 1/2"



Cut 5 squares that are 2 7/8" and then subcut these diagonally into 10 triangles.



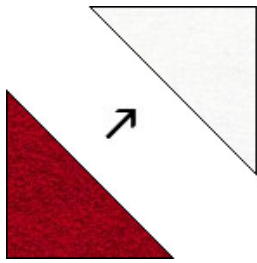
Cut 2 pieces that are 2 1/2" Square



Cut 5 squares that are 2 7/8" and then subcut these diagonally into 10 triangles.

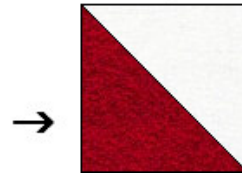


Cut 4 squares that are 4 1/2"



Using a 1/4" seam allowance sew your red and white triangles together as shown making a total of 10 half square triangles.

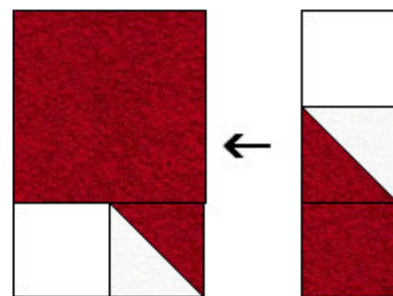
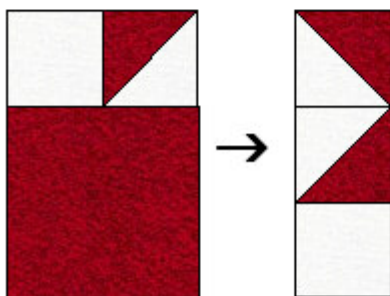
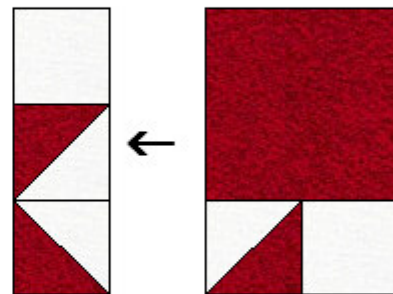
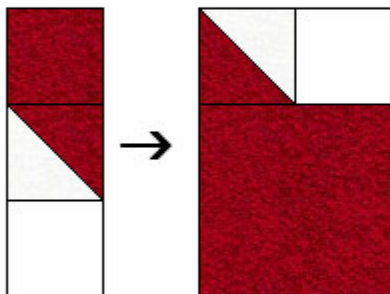
Press towards the red side.

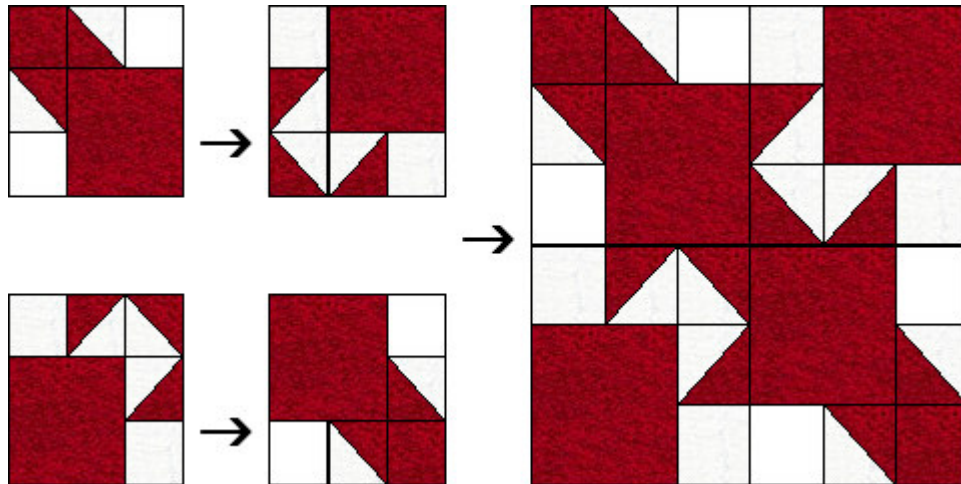


Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew together like this first, making 4 total units.

Be careful! It's easy to turn some of them the wrong way.

Take it slow and check with your picture to be sure the half square triangles are going the right way!





Using a 1/4" seam allowance sew the 4 units together making the cupid's arrow block. Press and your'e done!

Quilt Information included with this block!

Cupid's Arrow Quilt
84" by 84"

This quilt has 36 blocks

For borders and blocks you will need:

4 ¾ yard of Red

3 yards of Cream

You will need 1 yard of binding, color of choice (cut 9 strips that are 3 ½ " wide)

Cut Border pieces first!

There are 2 Vertical straight borders

Cream one is 2" wide (Cut 8 strips that are 3 ½ " wide by width of fabric)

Sew in pairs together to form 4 long strips

Red one is 4" wide(Cut 8 strips that are 4 ½" wide by width of fabric)

5 yards of Backing fabric (cut in half in 2 1/3 yard lengths and then sewed together along the long side)

For 36 total blocks in this quilt you will cut:

288 **Cream** 2 ½" squares

180 2 7/8" **Red** squares (cut diagonally into triangles)

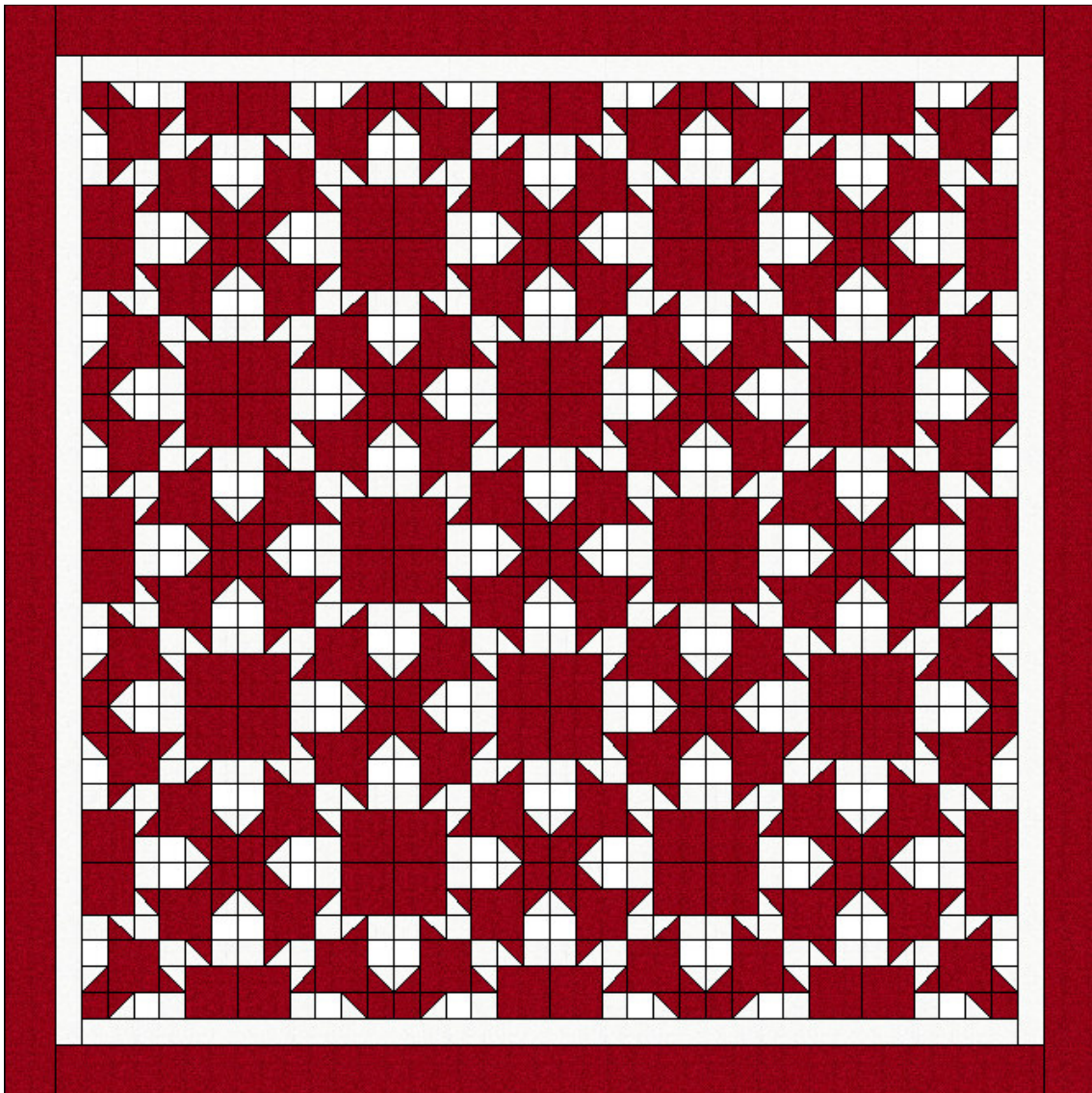
180 2 7/8" **Cream** squares (cut diagonally into triangles)

72 **Red** 2 ½ " squares

144 **Red** 4 ½" squares

When placing the blocks into the quilt, every other block is flipped when sewing the blocks into the quilt.

Be sure to lay out the blocks to make sure they are turned the correct way!
