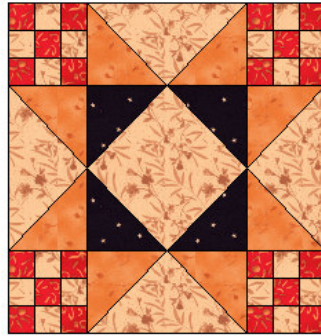






Ohio Nine Patch



-  Cut 4 pieces 3 1/2" by 3 1/2"
-  Cut 1 piece 6 1/2" by 6 1/2"
-  Cut 8 pieces 3 1/2" by 3 1/2"
-  Cut 4 pieces 3 1/2" by 6 1/2"




Cut 3 strips, in the dark fabric that are 1 1/2" by 18" and 3 strips in the light fabric that are 1 1/2" by 18" and sew together as shown in diagram.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3 1/2" black square, this will be your sewing line.

Place 3 1/2" piece black piece right sides together with the 6 1/2" square and sew diagonally then trim to 1/4" seam and press up. Repeat with other 3 sides



 Subcut these strips into 1 1/2" by 3 1/2" segments and sew together creating the checkerboard

You will need 8 pieces of dark light dark and 4 pieces of light dark light
Make a total of 4 of the checkerboards



Draw a line diagonally across the 3 1/2" square, this will be your sewing line.

Take the 6 1/2" by 3 1/2" rectangle and with right sides together sew a 3 1/2" square of your light fabric on the diagonal as shown.

Trim seam to 1/4" and press back.
Repeat with the other side and press

Make a total of 4 of the "Star Points"

Piece your block together, using picture of block as your guide!
