

Oklahoma Twister

12" Finished Block



Cut 20 squares that are 2 1/2" by 2 1/2"



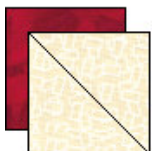
Cut 8 squares that are 2 7/8" by 2 7/8"



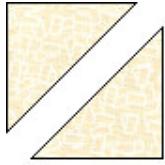
Cut 8 squares that are 2 7/8" by 2 7/8"



Take the white 2 7/8" squares and a pencil and mark a diagonal line through the center of each square



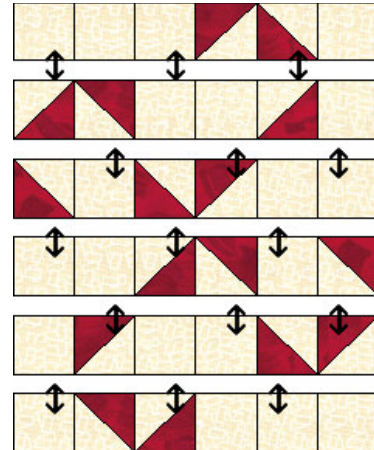
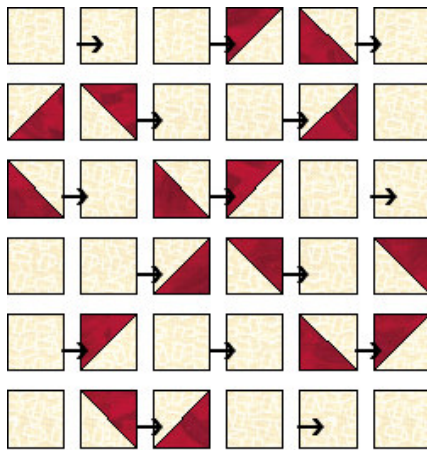
Lay the white 2 7/8" square on top of the red 2 7/8" squares, right sides together, and sew 1/4" from the center line on both sides.



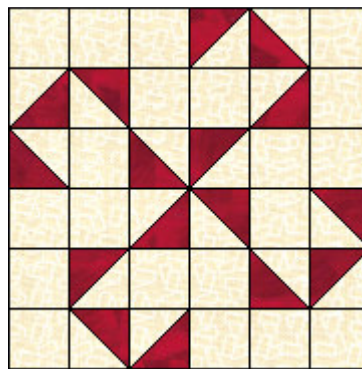
Press to set the seam and then cut apart on the center line that you drew with the pencil earlier. Gently press this open. You should now have 16 half square triangle blocks that look like this.



Lay out your squares and using a 1/4" seam, sew the squares together by the row, pressing each row in an opposite directions so the seams will lock together when sewing the rows together. Sew rows together and press.



Your block should now measure 12 1/2" square unfinished!
