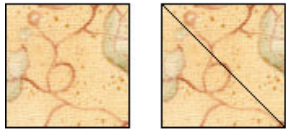


Prairie Queen

Finished block measures 12" wide and 12" high



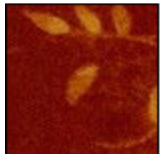
Cut 2 squares that are 5"
On the wrong sides, raw a diagonal line through the centers of each square.



Cut 2 squares that are 5"



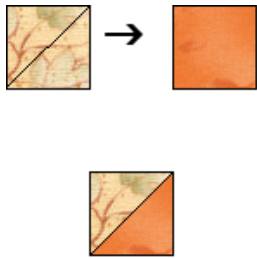
Cut 8 pieces that are 2 1/2 Inch Square



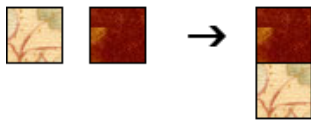
Cut 8 pieces that are 2 1/2 Inch Square



Cut 1.....4 1/2 Inch Square



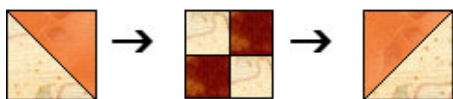
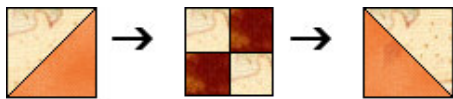
Pick up one of each 5" colored square, and put the right sides of the fabric together. Place the square with the drawn diagonal line on top and sew a scant 1/4" away from the drawn line on each side. Cut apart on the drawn line and press open to the dark side. Repeat with the other 5" squares. You should now have 4 half square triangles.



Take the 8 dark and 8 light 2 1/2" squares and sew them together to make pairs.



Sew the pairs together to make a total of four, 4 patch units.



Sew all pieces together using picture as a guide and there you have it!!
