Scotties Anyone!

8" Finished Block

Materials Needed:

10" White on White background piece

Scraps of black and plaid fabric

Thread to match fabric

Templates have been reversed for your convenience.

No seam allowance is figured into templates, if doing any appliqué but fusible, you will need to add a seam allowance.

Instructions using the freezer paper method of appliqué are given with pattern.

Instructions

Set page scaling to none in your printer properties before printing out the diagram and templates.

Make sure the measuring line on each page measures one inch. This is very important as the templates need to be the correct size.

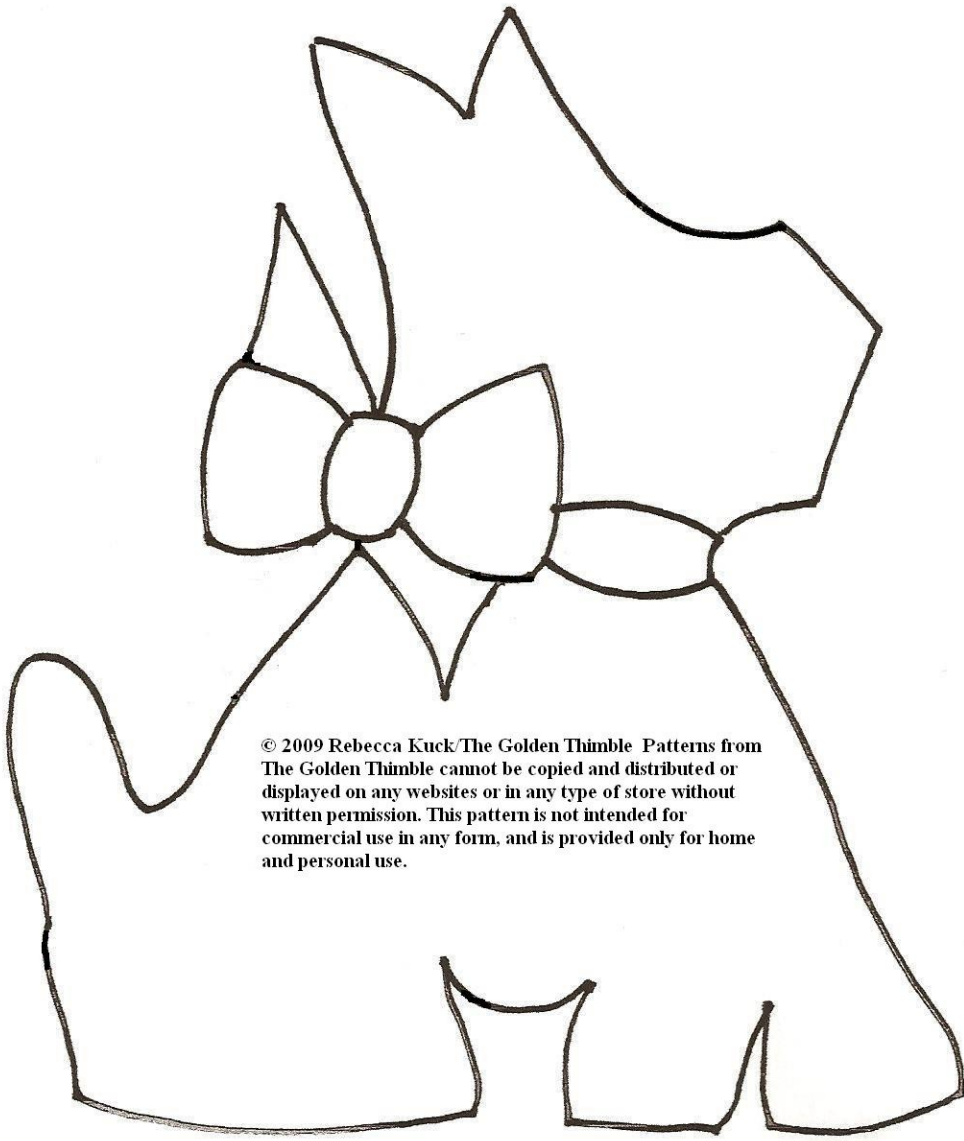
I made my block using the freezer paper method of appliqué.

- Trace templates onto the dull side of some freezer paper and cut out.
- Iron them onto the wrong side of your fabric.
- Cut around the freezer paper templates leaving a ¼” seam allowance.
- Thread a needle then turn the seam allowance and baste the edges down.
- Iron the templates.
- Carefully remove the thread and the paper
- Pieces have nice turned edges now and are ready to be pinned down to your background fabric
- If desired print out the placement diagram and place under the *10” fabric piece so you can lay your pieces on where they actually go.
- Starting with the bottom pieces first, work your way up to the top most piece to be appliquéd.
- Make sure that you use matching thread to appliqué your pieces!
- When finished appliquéing your block. Press and then trim to 8 ½” square.

Enjoy your little Scottie!

This would make a great kids quilt, Using a different fabric for each Scotties bow and maybe turning them back and forth?

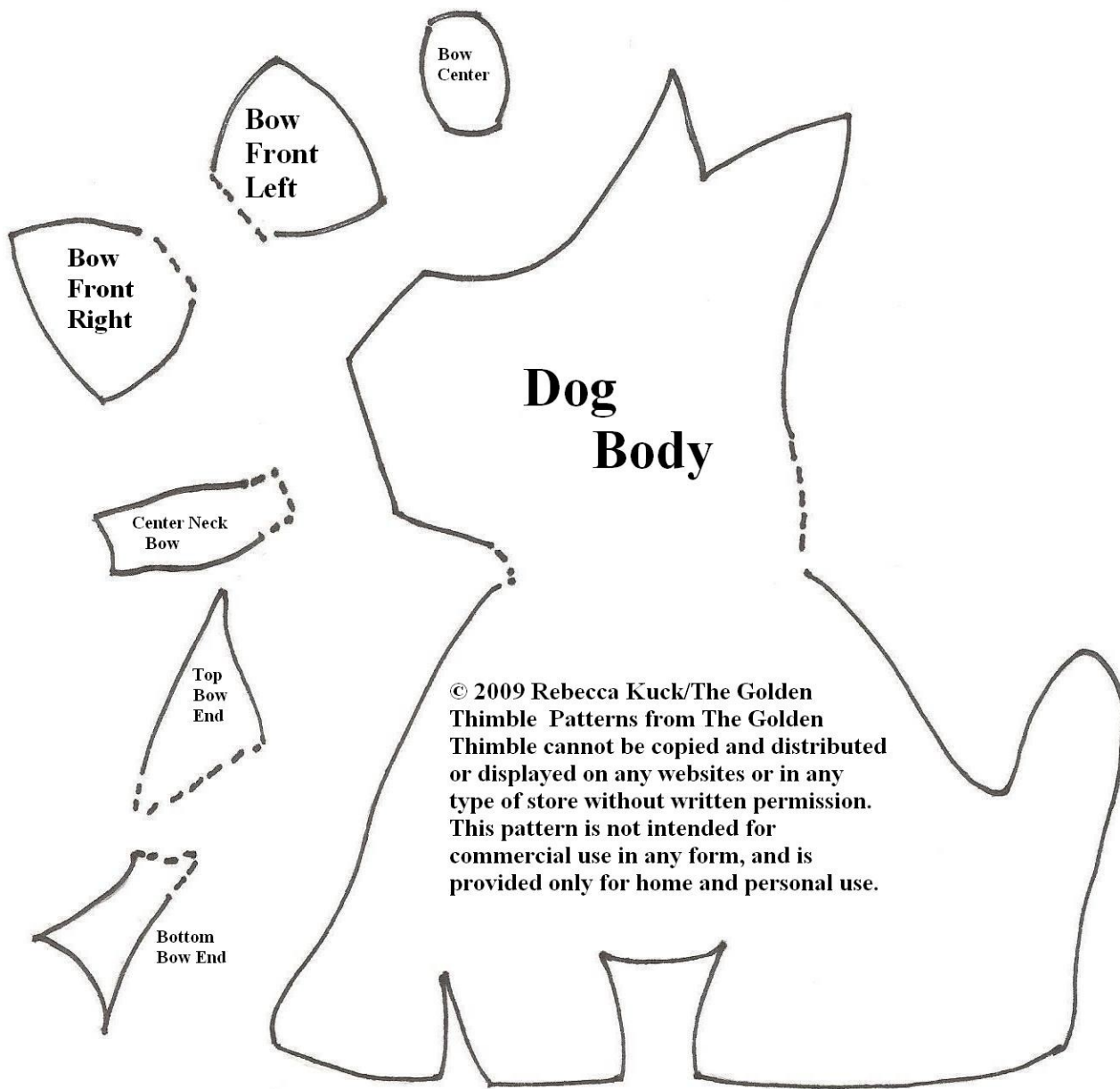
