12" by 12" Finished Block



Cut 4 squares at $2 \frac{3}{8}$ " and then subcut into 8 triangles



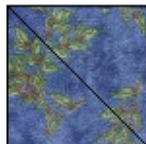
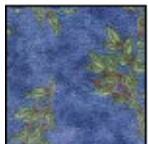
Cut 4 2" squares



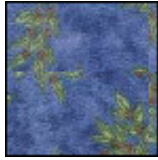
Cut 8 squares that are $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " and then mark a diagonal line through the center on the wrong side. This will be your sewing line.



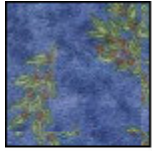
Cut 4 rectangles that are $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut 4 squares at $2 \frac{3}{8}$ " and then subcut into 8 triangles



Cut 4 2" squares



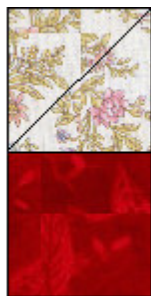
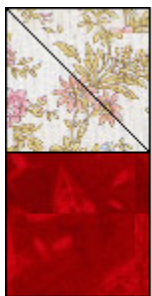
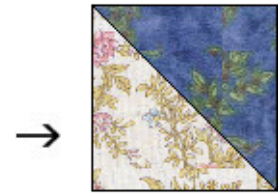
Cut 5 pieces that are 2 1/2" square



Cut 8 rectangles that are 2 1/2" by 3 1/2"



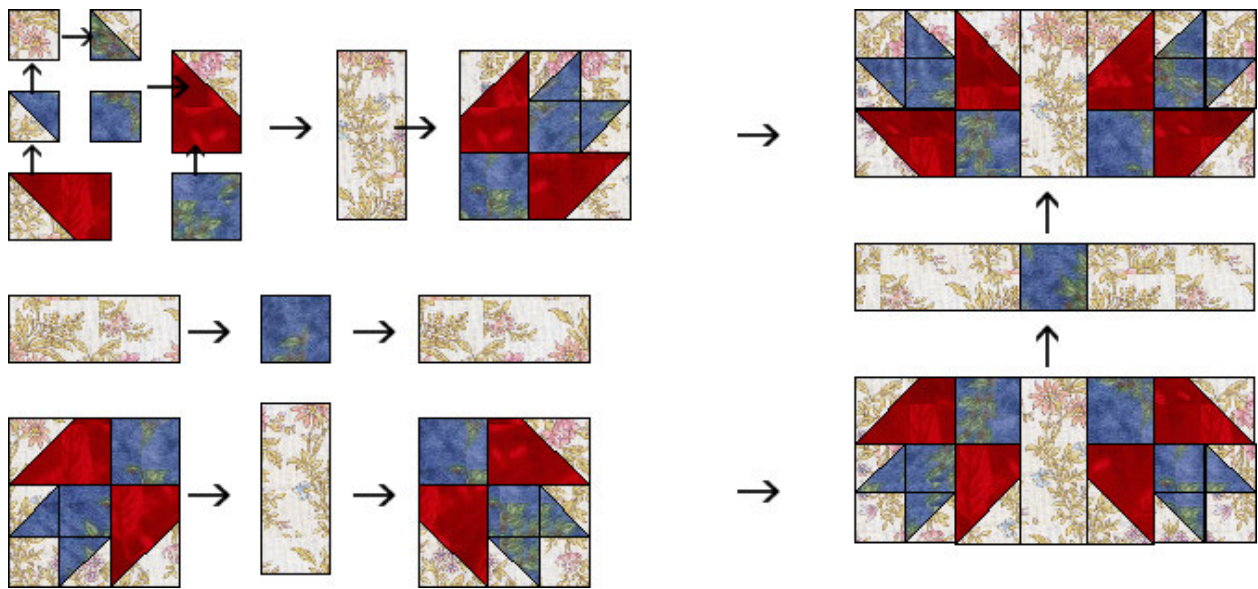
Take the small triangles that you cut from the 2 3/8" squares in the background color and the blue color and sew together using a 1/4" seam. Press towards the dark side. You should end up with a total of 8 half square triangles



Take the 2 1/2" squares that you drew the line on the wrong side, and with right sides together as shown in the picture, sew on the drawn line and then trim up, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Do this for all 8 pieces and press. Be sure to alternate sides as shown. You should now have 4 going one way and 4 going the other way.



Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew your block together and press.



Your block should now measure 12 1/2" unfinished!

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
