

Victorian Fan



12" by 12" Finished

Basic Instructions are for 1 block on point

Please read through all instructions before beginning the project!

Seam allowance is figured into the templates for your convenience.

When printing out templates, remember to set the page scaling to none in your printer properties so the templates print out accurate. Measure the line given on the templates to see if it measures 1" long, if it does you are ready to go!

Instructions

Cut 1 red heart

Cut 3 fan blades and then reverse the template and cut 3 reversed fan blades for a total of 6 fan blades. (3 regular and 3 reversed)

Cut your white on white background 13" for appliqué.

Using the picture as your guide for fan blade placement, sew the fan blades together as shown, using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams apart. Cut out the heart piece, remembering that the seam allowance is already figured in!

Place the blades and heart on point, on your background fabric, pin down and appliqué using your favorite method. I used the needle turn method for this block.

When you are finished appliquéing press and trim background square to 12 1/2" unfinished!

Please note.....

If you want to add setting triangles, this is the formula!

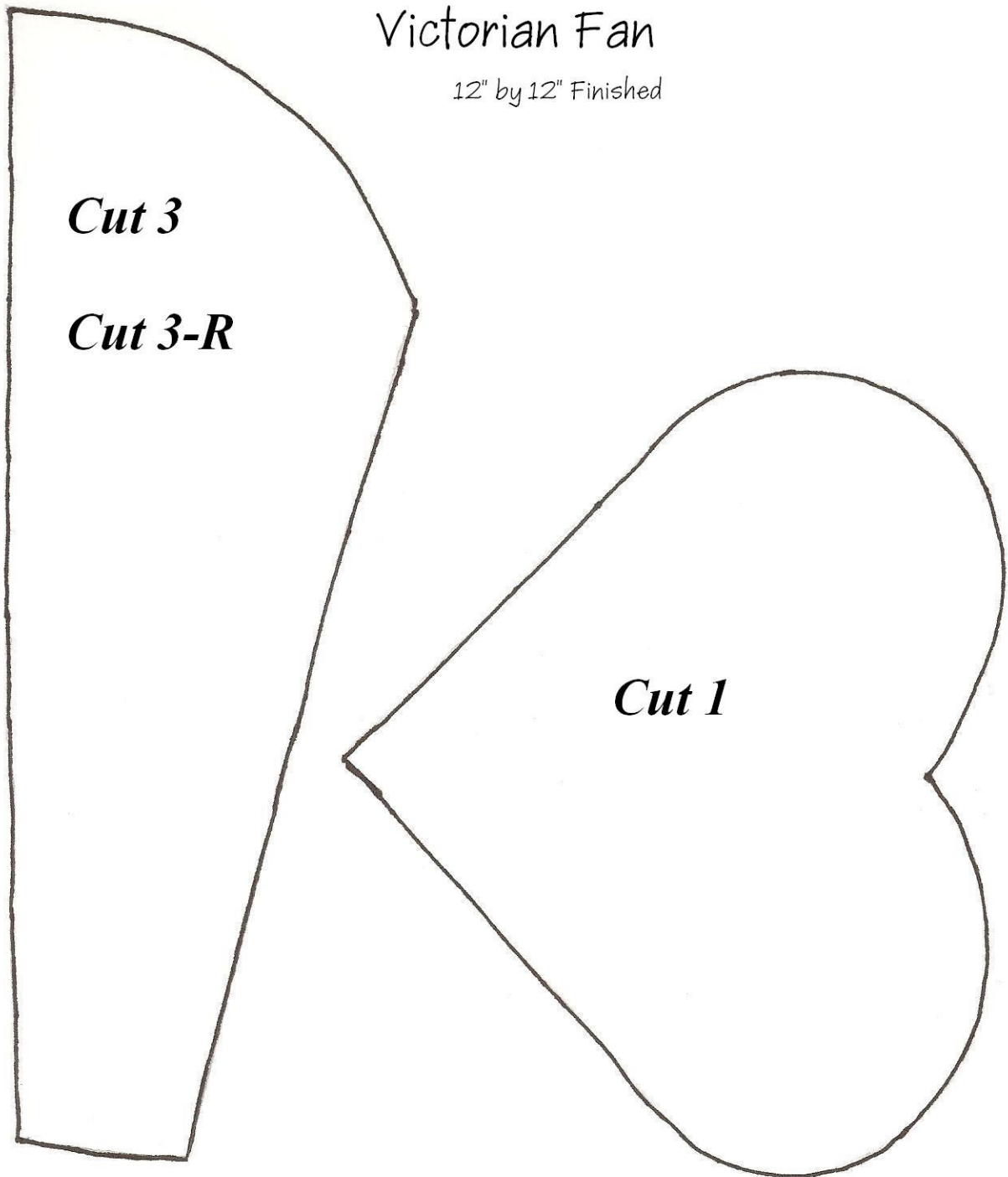
The setting triangles for this block are 2 squares cut at 9 3/8" and then subcut into 2 triangles, each square, for a total of 4 triangles per Victorian Fan block. With the setting triangles applied, your block will measure 17" by 17" Finished.

FYI.....

This would make a beautiful quilt at 4 blocks wide by 5 blocks high on point with setting triangles and a 6" scalloped border. Quilt would measure approx. 80" by 96"
